- 1) **Facilities for the under 16's:** We were asked how much of the council's budget goes towards facilities for the under 16's.

The majority of Parish Council funds are spent on shared resources and are not aimed at any specific age groups. However, by way of indication, 5% of the budget is spent on the sports field which is used by all ages. Last year, part of the budget was spent on cricket nets. Young people are represented through articles in the Thornborough News. The greens are available for use by all ages.

- 2) **Net-Paving:** Work has been completed on the green outside the village hall. Kerbing has been installed along the edge abutting High Street. A netpaving system has been put along the edge opposite the village hall and the area re-seeded. We hope to do the same on the green opposite The Two Brewers and outside the sports field at Back Street at a future date.

The Parish Council will always act on behalf of the entire village, which is one of the loveliest villages in Buckinghamshire.
