

THORNBOROUGH VILLAGE HALL TRUST

The trust property shall be held upon trust for the purposes of a village hall for the use of the inhabitants of the Parish of Thornborough in the County of Buckinghamshire without distinction of political, religious or other opinions, including use for meetings, lectures and classes, and for other forms of recreation and leisure-time occupation, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants.

Committee of Management

The charity shall be administered in conformity with the provisions of the trust deed by the committee of management.

The TVH management committee comprises of people representing village voluntary organisations and individuals. Some of these people are also trustees, registered with the charities commission. Any voluntary organisation based in Thornborough, Bucks may put forward a representative and indeed the committee would like all these organisations to be involved.

The trust deed lists some but not all current organisations:

One representative member shall be appointed by each of the following organisations:

- Thornborough Football Club
- Friendship Club
- Parents and Friends of Thornborough School (PAFOTS)
- Millennium Club
- Thornborough and Thornton Gardening Society
- Thornborough Morris and Appalachian
- Thornborough Sports and Social Committee

A representative member shall ordinarily be appointed not more than one month before the annual general meeting. Each organisation shall notify the secretary of the committee the name of its representative. In the event of any application for representation on the committee being received from any other village organisation the committee may, upon a resolution supported at a duly constituted meeting of the committee by the votes of a majority of not less than two-thirds of all the members of the committee, allow such organisation to appoint a representative member to the management committee.

Custodian Trustee

The Parish Council of Thornborough, Buckinghamshire is the custodian trustee of the charity and the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Public Trustee Act 1906 apply to the said council and to the committee respectively in like manner as they apply to the Public Trustee and managing trustees.
